Prepare Your Workplace with Free Life-Saving Training!

B-Con is designed for people with little or no medical training

- Teachers, security personnel, custodial staff
- Public servants who may be called upon to assist trauma patients while waiting for EMS.

B-Con teaches basic life-saving interventions

- Bleeding control with a tourniquet, gauze pack or hemostatic agent
- Opening an airway to allow a casualty to breathe.

B-Con was developed to increase survival from

- Active shooter, improvised explosive device, and mass casualty events.
